

REMINDERS:

1. Applicants are advised to take their meals prior to coming over for their medical examination since food is not allowed within the premises and all the initial blood and urine tests do not require a fasting state.
2. Females within the reproductive age group are advised not to schedule their medical examination during their menstrual period. Otherwise, they will be required to come back one week after the last day of their menstruation.
3. FOR PREGNANT Applicants please bring OB_Gyne consent prior to x-ray.
4. Applicants who have been scheduled for additional examinations must come on their designated examination date and time.

B. 3 pcs picture passport size (recent photo within 6 months old, white background)

C. 3 photocopies of letter/Medical instruction from the embassy (if available)

* If Passport not available, the following identity documents may be presented:

- Valid ID's (Government issued ID's)
 - Driver's license
 - Voter's ID (laminated version with photo)
 - NSO Birth certificate
 - Social Security System (SSS) ID
 - Professional Regulations Commission (PRC) ID
 - School ID

E. 3 good quality photocopies (preferably in color) of Passport/Valid ID's clearly showing photo, name and date of birth

F. Please bring black ball pen

G. Non-fasting

H. Bring all medical records if available

- Old chest x-ray films not less than 3 months prior to the medical examination
- Detailed medical certificate regarding a previously-treated or currently managed clinically significant illness which should contain the following information:
 - duration and date of treatment
 - surgical procedure or medical intervention done
 - complete final diagnosis
 - outcome of treatment or treatment plans and prognosis, if available

REQUIRED MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS

Age	Required Examinations
0 - 4 years old	Physical Examination
5 - 10 years old	Physical Examination, urinalysis
11 - 14 years old	Physical Examination, urinalysis, chest x-ray (CXR)
15 years old and above	Physical Examination, urinalysis, RPR, HIV, HBSAG, Anti-HCV, FCBC, HA1C, CREA, Chest x-ray (CXR)
